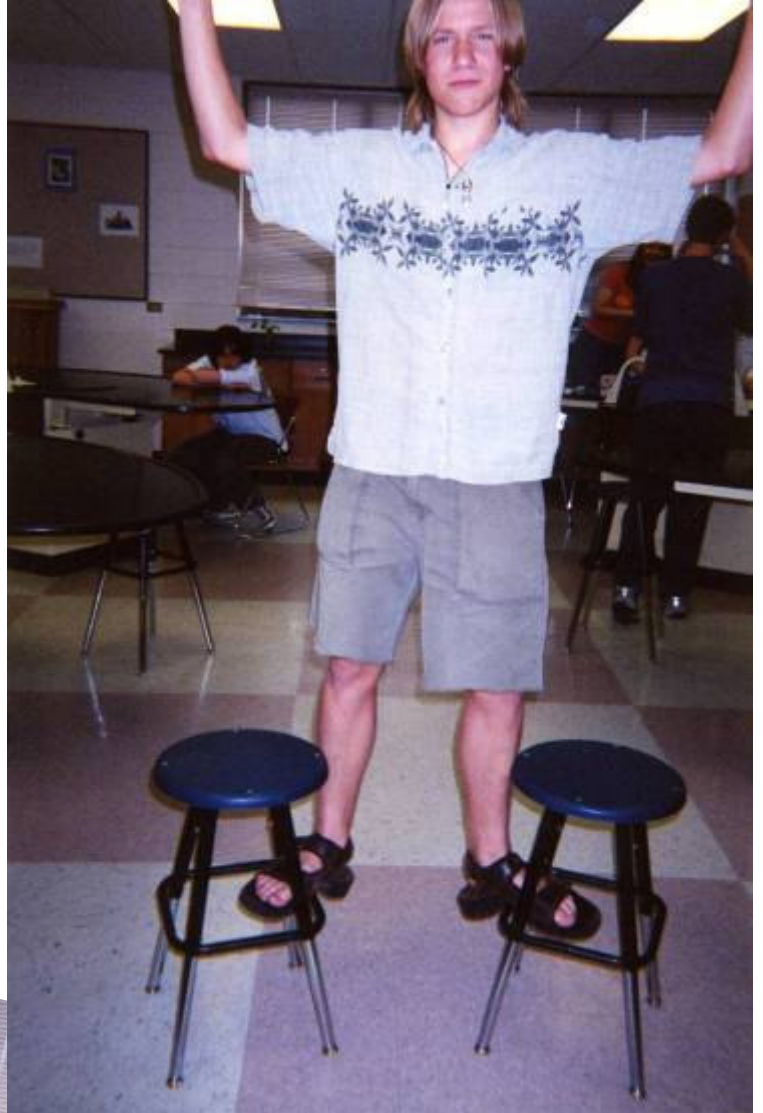
Oh no! This is the "up-only" staircase!
